### INDIANA'S 2020 COLLEGE-GOING RATE

- > 53% of high school graduates went to college the following year
  - ▶ 12 percentage point decline from 2015 to 2020
  - National context: 62.7% of American high school grads, about a 6 percentage point decline from 2015
- ► 81% of 21st Century Scholars go to college






### INDIANA'S "MISSING" BLACK GRADUATES






## HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES ARE BECOMING MORE DIVERSE




#### GEOGRAPHY






#### AP & DUAL CREDIT

Scholars are the most likely group to earn AP or dual credit








#### COLLEGE-GOING RATES

59% of Indiana's high school grads go straight to college




#### COLLEGE-GOING RATES

#### WHERE HIGH SCHOOL GRADS GO TO COLLEGE




### COMPLETIONS AT TWO-YEAR INSTITUTIONS
