

Indiana Stats-Disproportionality for Child Welfare

- In Indiana for the year 2014 76% of African American children and 39% of Hispanic and Latino children lived in a single parent home, compared to their non-Hispanic whites at 29%.
- African Americans are over-represented in foster care, comprising approximately 28% of those in care in Indiana, even though they constitute 8.9% of the state's youth population. Latino youth are slightly over-represented, comprising 5% of the foster care population, compared with 4.3% of the general youth population.
