

# Indiana Stats-Disproportionality for Education

- Indiana is among the five states with the highest disparities for suspension rates for African American children (US DOE Civil Rights data collection, 2014).
- Indiana and Missouri tie as second worst states in the suspension of Black males (US DOE Civil Rights data collection, 2014).
- Black students are suspended and expelled at a rate three times greater than white students (US DOE Civil Rights data collection, 2014).
- 70% of all school arrests involve minority students, mostly African American and Hispanic youth (Office of Civil Rights, 2010).
